Late last week Equifax Inc. announced a cybersecurity incident potentially impacting approximately 143 million U.S. consumers. Criminals exploited a U.S. Equifax website application vulnerability to gain access to certain Equifax files. Based on the Equifax investigation, the unauthorized access occurred from mid-May through July 2017.

Warren Financial has the ability to determine if your information has been potentially impacted by this Equifax event and notify you if it has been flagged. With your permission, we will follow up with Equifax on your behalf.
